

ASBESTOS DISPOSAL

Two EASY Steps to Safe Disposal

Step One: Prepare the Material

Residentially Generated Material Instructions:

1. 'Wet' the tiles/insulation/etc with spray bottle filled with water.
2. Use – 2 – 6 mil poly bags to contain the 'wetted' tiles/insulation/etc.
3. Tie up poly bags.
4. Tape up seams of poly bags and opening area with heavy duty packing tape

Commercially Generated Material Instructions:

1. Contact MPCA for further instruction on preparation manifests needed, etc.

Step Two: Drop-Off

1. Alex Rubbish and Recycling - Hwy 29 North – 320-763-4712

Accept asbestos containing materials – like ceiling tiles/insulation/siding/shingles/flooring.

Asbestos siding, flooring, shingles that take fill up a truck load or roll-off and can't be bagged – contact Alex Rubbish and Recycling. They offer a service to transport asbestos materials to the Morrison County Landfill for a fee.

Asbestos containing adhesives and roof tars BRING to Pope Douglas Solid Waste Management's Household Hazardous Waste Facility.

2. Morrison County Landfill – Little Falls – 320-632-1944

Accept asbestos containing materials – like ceiling tiles/insulation/siding/shingles/flooring.

Manifests are not needed for **Residentially** Generated Materials.

Manifests are required for **Commercially** Generated Materials.

Materials must be properly prepared for disposal.
