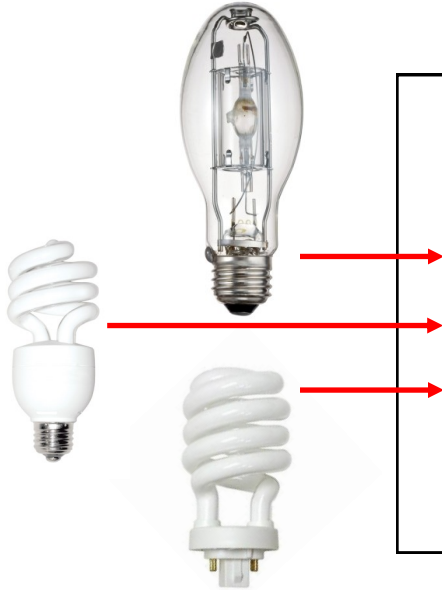

Management of Crushed Bulbs/Broken Up Bulbs

- Place in 5 gallon container with lid—do not use box/bag
- Write on lid 'Crushed Bulbs'
- Bring along on day of drop-off

Large Quantity Bulbs must be boxed up if barrels are not used.

Do not mix small CFLs/HID/etc with tube bulbs

Do not mix crushed/broken up bulbs with intact bulbs



Swap Out Lamp Barrel Request/Bulb Prep for Drop Off

Ballasts/Capacitors/Batteries/Thermostats - Do Not Mix With Bulbs!

We Accept: Button Batteries, Auto, Sealed Lead Acid, Lithium, Rechargeable Batteries (Ni-Cd, Ni-MH, Li-Ion)
Bring in ALL Batteries for proper recycling, **except the 'Alkaline' type batteries.** 'Alkaline' style go in regular trash.

We Accept: PCB and Non-PCB Ballasts, Capacitors, Mercury Switches/Thermostats.
