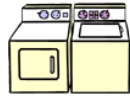

Clean Up Day Procedure:

1. Residents must enter the Liquor Store parking lot at the far east entrance and line up at the back of the building.
2. An attendant will be there to check you in and pay for your drop-off items at this time.
3. Once you have checked in and paid for your items you will be directed where to unload, volunteers will help unload items. When finished unloading you must exit the parking lot at the far west exit.



Yard Waste:

Individuals that missed the yard waste pick up the morning of May 13th can bring their bagged yard waste to the Liquor Store for disposal by 11am.

Batteries

- Alkaline, AA, AAA, C and D (Non-Rechargeable) batteries may be disposed of in your **regular trash**.
- Button Batteries (wrist watch and hearing aid type) **accepted** in HHW.
- Car batteries are **accepted** at the Recycling Center.
- Lead Batteries (small, sealed Lead/Pb batteries) **accepted** in HHW.
- Lithium Batteries **accepted** in HHW.
- Rechargeable Batteries (Ni-Cd, Ni-MH, Li-Ion) **accepted** in HHW.
- Bring in ALL Batteries for proper recycling, except the 'Alkaline' type batteries.



Bulb Recycling - up to 20 bulbs per household

- Pope/Douglas Facility in Alex accepts them year-round
- NO Incandescent or LED type bulbs will be accepted!

NO Motor Oil/Filters

Motor Oil and Oil Filters would not be accepted... people can recycle these items at service garages or at the PDSWM Recycling Center in Alex.
