Covid-19 Restrictions and Protocol

Pope/Douglas operates a convenient Special Burn/Non-Hazardous Industrial Burn program to assist businesses do the right thing with their non-hazardous industrial wastes to **minimize environmental risk**. Pope/Douglas recognizes that contractors, vendors and haulers of these wastes are considered 'essential'.

However, Pope/Douglas also wants to **minimize employee exposures and sickness** relating to Covid-19.

We are restricting all haulers and delivery employees from entering the Scale Room/Office Area of the Waste-to-Energy Facility.

Access to Office or Scale Room bathroom facilities are restricted. Restroom options include Cenex – 1 block west of Pope/Douglas – just off Broadway Street.

1. Arrive at Pope/Douglas (Gate B) – commercial entrance.
2. Roll up onto truck scale, after an employee motions for you to do so.
3. You will be instructed to drive around to the north side of facility
4. Unbolt/remove all drum rings/lids/straps.
5. Pope/Douglas employee will meet you to unload trailers/trucks/barrel tipper/etc.
6. Social distancing of at least 6 feet must be maintained between Pope/Douglas employee and haulers/delivery employees.
7. No hand-signing of Special Burn documents will be done.
8. Pope/Douglas will email haulers/delivery vendors & companies 'Proof of Destruction'.

Do not enter Pope/Douglas Solid Waste Campus if you are experiencing known symptoms of COVID-19 or other contagions.
