



Compostable Dinnerware Vendors

Not all disposable dinnerware is the same. As part of your commercial or household organics recycling program – you must use certified compostable options if you decide to use disposable, rather than reusable, dinnerware. Using plastic disposable dinnerware or 'shiny' plastic coated paper plates are not allowed as they do not break down in the composting process.

Dinnerware that is certified by the Biodegradable Products Institute (BPI) – third party certification organization – are required.

Dinnerware that is labeled as 'degradable', 'biodegradable', or 'made from plants' are not compostable. Rather, they break down into smaller pieces of plastic, which contaminate the finished compost.
