Items NOT accepted: (at Temp Site)

Some items that were accepted at the Jefferson site will not be accepted at the Temp Site due to space constraints and site land use requirements.

- Household Confidential Documents
- Waste Oil/Filters. Bring to Plaza Tire disposal site (501 30th Ave W)
- Empty Pesticide Container/Jug Recycling
- Scrap Metal/Wire/Non-Freon Appliances. Bring to Douglas County Demo Facility, Northern Metal Recycling/EMR (Glenwood), Tom Kraemer Inc (Glenwood), South Environmental Drop Site (Starbuck).
